This is an election year so I hope everyone will attend to support the candidate of your choice.

For the ladies program, they will be attending the Morton Arboretum, where they will be given a 60 minute tour of the Arboretum and then enjoy a buffet lunch.

As everyone knows, Pension Bill SB1 was declared Unconstitutional by the Illinois Supreme Court. The court forced the State to find another way to fix the nation's worst government-employee pension crisis ruling lawmakers "overstepped" by enacting a law that slashed retirement benefits to confront a large budget deficit. The court stated that the bill violates the State constitution because it would leave pension promises "diminished or impaired". State lawyers while in court had to defend "decades of skipped pension's contributions by the STATE that largely created the disaster". They attempted to end-run constitutional concerns by invoking "police powers" in times of crisis, but the court disagreed, saying such measures were reserved for true public-safety-threat situations. Stay tuned to see what Springfield is going to try next.

There's nothing new to report on as far as the law suit against the Association and the Sherwood Youth Camp. On June 4th, the last motions were filed in reference to the motion of discoveries. The next court date is August 19th, at the Daley Center, it's in reference to the change of venue. As I get more information, I will notify the Division Chairmen.

I'm happy to say that the membership has increased this year compared to last year's totals. I hope that everyone will continue to do their best in signing up new members. Keep up the good work.

In 1994 the IPA Board decided to implement the annual scholarship award program. There were two dominant reasons for this decision:

1. To offer a recruitment incentive to prospective new members of the Illinois Police Association.
2. To reward our current members for their continued commitment and support for the organization.

On January 16, 2004, the Scholarship Committee held a meeting and reviewed the guidelines of the program. These guidelines were approved by the IPA Executive Board on April 6, 2004 to administer the program in a more efficient and effective manner for the benefit of our membership.

This information is being published to educate applicants and as a guideline for division officers during their review and processing of all required documentation.

All division chairmen will receive a copy of these guidelines and are expected to follow them to that their applicants receive proper consideration for the award. Any and all questions regarding eligibility should be directed to the corresponding division chairman. The scholarship committee of the Illinois Police Association will ultimately review all submitted applications for compliance and has the final decision regarding the awarding of scholarship funds.

The scholarship committee has worked hard to ensure the success of this ongoing program and asks that the following rules are strictly followed. Thank you for your consideration.

Eligibility:

1. A child (natural or legally adopted), regardless of residency, of an Active or Active Paid Up life member or a stepchild who resides in the same household of the IPA member. The applicant must be under the age of 24 as of November 1 of the corresponding scholarship year.
2. The member must be in good standing with the IPA for least one year prior to the date of application.
3. The scholarship applicant must be a full time student carrying a minimum of 12 credit hours per semester or an equivalent number of hours per quarter in an undergraduate capacity.
4. Full time nursing students who meet the above criteria are eligible to apply.

Persons who are not eligible:

1. IPA members or spouses.
2. Students in a trade, industrial or graduate school.
3. Part time students carrying less than 12 credit hours per semester or an equivalent number of hours per quarter.

Eligibility will be predicated upon each division's roster of Active or Active Paid Up life members as of May 1 of the current year. No transfer of members to a different division will be made within 12 months prior to the deadline for application submissions (November 1 of each year) for the purpose of benefiting in the scholarship award program. Applicants may apply to only one division.

Scholarship Expenditures:

1. The current award will be \$500.00 per school year per student. Each eligible student in a family may apply.
2. Award winners may reapply annually.
3. The Illinois Police Association, Inc. will remit one lump sum payment of \$500.00 to award winner. The payment will be made after the division chairman submits the winning application with all necessary supplementary documentation to the IPA office. All winning applications will then be reviewed and ultimately approved by the scholarship committee.
4. Each of the 13 divisions of the IPA will receive one scholarship annually (if so submitted) at a cost to the association of \$6,500.00

Procedure for Selection:

All applications will be collected and screened by each division for eligibility and the submission of all necessary documentation. After proper verification the division board will prepare the names of all candidates for a random drawing. The winner will be drawn by the chairman at a regular meeting of the division no later than the 30th day of November in the corresponding year. The chairman will also draw the name of the one alternate winner who will not be announced.

Should the announced winner be ineligible for any reason then the alternate be awarded the scholarship and announced at a later date. Divisions should retain all submitted applications in event that the alternate is also found ineligible and yet another winner may have to be selected.

The winning application with all supportive documentation will be forwarded to the IPA office by the division secretary no later than December 15. Pending the receipt of all documentation in a timely manner, announcements of the official winners will be made by the chairman of the scholarship committee at the earliest scheduled board meeting.

If any division fails to submit the name an eligible winner no scholarship will be awarded to said division. Winners of the scholarships will be eligible to reapply the following year.

Verification of Eligibility:

The following must accompany all applications:

1. A copy of the applicant's current class schedule.
2. A copy of an invoice or statement from the bursar's office indicating full or partial tuition payment.
3. A copy or printout of a financial instrument electronic or other document showing full or partial tuition payment.

Important dead lines to remember:

- *November 1 - Application due to division chairman
- *November Division meeting -Random drawing
- *December 15 -Winning application due at IPA office

IPA Kickapoo Division 2015 Scholarship Award Program



ILLINOIS POLICE ASSOCIATION, INC. KICKAPOO DIVISION 2015 Scholarship Award Program



In 1994 the Statewide Illinois Police Association, Inc. Board decided to implement an Annual Scholarship Award Program. On January 16, 2004, the state scholarship committee reviewed the guidelines which were then approved by the IPA Executive Board on April 6, 2004.

The IPA Scholarship Program authorized each of the 13 Divisions one scholarship annually (if so submitted) at a cost to the IPA of \$6,500.00 which is so budgeted. Guidelines, procedures and deadline dates are available to each Division each year.

The IPA Scholarship Program has proven quite successful and has met the IPA's criteria of serving as a recruitment incentive to prospective new members and to reward current members for their continued commitment and organization support.

On November 13, 2014 members in attendance at the monthly meeting of the IPA Kickapoo Division discussed introducing a Kickapoo Division Scholarship Awards Program in addition to the statewide IPA Scholarship Program. Discussion followed in favor of such a program but suggesting that the award be given from members within this Division; that scholarship award applications be authorized by and accepted from only active and currently paid dues members of the Kickapoo Division; and that the Eligibility for Scholarship Award be expanded to include grandchildren of Active or Active Paid Up Life Member, who need not reside in the same household with the IPA Member but reside in and attend a State of Illinois college or university.

Division Chair Larry Kerns appointed a committee consisting of Ken Thomason and Chub Conner to prepare and present guidelines for presentation at the next monthly meeting on December 11, 2014.

On December 11, 2014 the appointed scholarship committee submitted a proposed Kickapoo Division Scholarship report and proposed scholarship program that included a proposed application form. The proposed Scholarship was discussed with a few basic changes. The issue was tabled until next monthly meeting where suggestions will be implemented and further discussion may continue.

ILLINOIS POLICE ASSOCIATION, INC. KICKAPOO DIVISION 2015 Scholarship Award Program Guidelines



This Scholarship Award Program, as established by and for Active and Active Paid Up Life members of the Kickapoo Division of the Illinois Police Association.

The program is intended to expand upon the principles and purposes of the ISA Scholarship Program, serving as a recruitment incentive to prospective new members, to reward our current members for their continued commitment and support and demonstrate community support by police to help Illinois children become well educated adults.

Scholarships are to be utilized at institutions of higher learning within the State of Illinois. The IPA funds are intended to assist the student with the cost of tuition, books and fees.

The Kickapoo Division Scholarship Award will be budgeted and funded within our Division. It will be awarded in addition to our participation with the state ISA Scholarship Award Program.

Eligibility:

A child or grandchild (naturally or legally adopted), permanent residents of the State of Illinois of an Active or Active Paid Up Life Member or a stepchild/step-grandchild. The applicant must be under the age of 24 as of the end of the calendar year of the application.

The member must be in good standing with the IPA for at least one year prior to the date of the application.

The scholarship applicant must be a full time student carrying a minimum of 12 credit hours per semester or an equivalent number of hours per quarter and in an undergraduate capacity.

Full time nursing or qualified health professions student who meet the above criteria are eligible to apply.

Persons Not Eligible;

IPA Members or spouses.

Students in a trade, industrial or graduate school.

Part time students carrying less than 12 credit hours per semester or an equivalent number of hours per quarter.

Eligibility will be predicated upon our Division Roster of Active or Active Paid Up Life Members as of May 1 of the current year. No transfer of members to a different Division will be made within 12 months prior to the deadline for application submissions for the purpose of benefiting in the scholarship award program.

Applicant's family member must be a member of the IPA Kickapoo Division.

Award winners may re-apply annually.

The payment will be made after completed application(s) and supportive information are submitted by Active or Active Paid Up Life Member(s) and a final vote of selection is completed.

Application(s) and information is to be verified on each application submitted. It (they) will be submitted to the membership at a regularly scheduled meeting for review, one month in advance of the vote for final selection of award winner. The Kickapoo Division Chairman will appropriately announce the winner.

When possible, an alternate winner will be selected should the selected winner be ineligible for any reason. The alternate will then be awarded the scholarship and announced at a later date.

Verification of Eligibility;

The following must accompany all applications;

- A copy of the applicant's current class schedule.

- A copy of an invoice or statement from the Bursar's Office indicating enrollment and full or partial tuition payment having been made.

- A type written or legibly hand written multi-paragraph statement, written by the applicant that states the applicant's plan/goals and purpose for attaining a college education.

Selection Process;

The selection process in instances of multiple applications will be by lottery drawing during an open meeting of the IPA Kickapoo Division.
